

## Rules and Regulations

1. It is the responsibility of the Artist or Person in Charge to transfer all information regarding entertainer participation to all group members. Arm Bands will be given to the appropriate member after I.D. identification. There must be a representative present at morning notes to convey any updates from the fair board.
2. The Mother Lode Highland Games employs a zero tolerance drug policy. Anyone using drugs will be required to leave and will not be invited to return.
3. Smoking is not permitted within the Fairgrounds and enforced by Fairgrounds personnel.
4. Camping is available and encouraged for performers. All performers must have a valid I.D. to check in at camping area and be on the guild gate list. **Gate lists must be submitted no later than June 1, 2017 as a pdf form to: [guilds@motherlodegames.com](mailto:guilds@motherlodegames.com).** Please check with the festival Line producer for more information. See phone number on cover letter. **This faire allows group to camp in their encampments.**
5. NO PETS are allowed on festival grounds without written approval from festival management prior to festival first day event.
6. Participants consent to the use of their names, pictures, images, recorded voice, or music in connection with festival events and without inspection for such purposes and commercial or promotional use.
7. Campfires are not allowed this year due to the currant fire restrictions.
8. All artist/group members agree to comply with festival, Federal, State, County, and local ordinances and /or regulations.
9. For living history groups, members agree to not dismantle encampments prior to 5pm on Sunday night. Dismantling your encampment creates distraction from the main stage performers before the close of the festival.
10. All members agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Mother Lode Games, Inc (festival production company), Amador and Plymouth Community Broadcast Group, Inc. (the Plymouth County fairgrounds or any other festival site or management, their officers, boards, employees, volunteers, independent contractors, or agents for liability and any damages whatsoever, including, but not limited to, property damage, personal injury or death arising out of or in any manner connected with the use of premises, without festivals permission.
11. Renaissance actors and any member of the entertainment guilds understand this is a volunteer acting performance.
